<p><b>Other change** This collection is currently active through 11/20/2010.</b>                  The Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008 (<b>Pub.L.110-315</b>) makes several minor changes in Section 606 of 20 U.S.C. 1126 to clarify the intent of the prior legislation. It clarifies the eligibility section by replacing the word consortia with the word partnerships, and adds a new section that again lists all the eligible entities and the partnerships that can be formed between these entities. It clarifies that information may be received from foreign sources.                  Under authorized activities the new legislation clarifies prior language by adding: (1) that funds may be used to acquire and facilitate access to materials from foreign sources; (2) that grants may be used to establish linkages between the applicant(s) and institutions, nonprofit educational organizations and libraries overseas; and (3) that funds may be used to carry out other activities that the Secretary determines are consistent with the purpose of the grants awarded.                  These activities are optional for applicants and therefore the burden is not increased.</p>
