3. That our company will report to the Committee all shipments of processing potatoes received from the Oregon-California production area. Such shipments will be reported by immediately submitting to the Committee the Special Purpose Shipment form sent by the shipper and received with the potato shipment. Such shipments will be identified by name of receiver, address of receiver, date received, hundredweight received, and special purpose for which the potatoes will be utilized. The form is to be signed and dated.
4. That failure to report, or the filing of false or incomplete reports, will result in the removal of my company from the list of approved manufacturers.
