A profile is defined by all combinations of age category, gender, various chronic conditions, and dual-eligibility status of the beneficiaries. Hence, the number of rows (or records) in the CMS 2008 Chronic Conditions represents the number of unique profiles in the Medicare population. For each profile many claim-related variables are provided in the form of averages.

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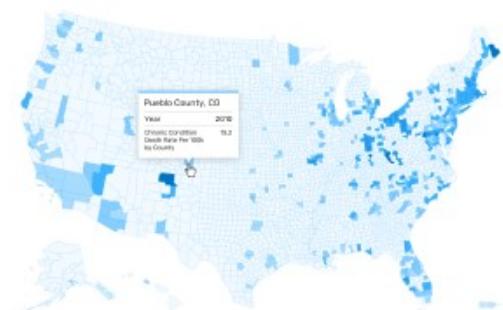
