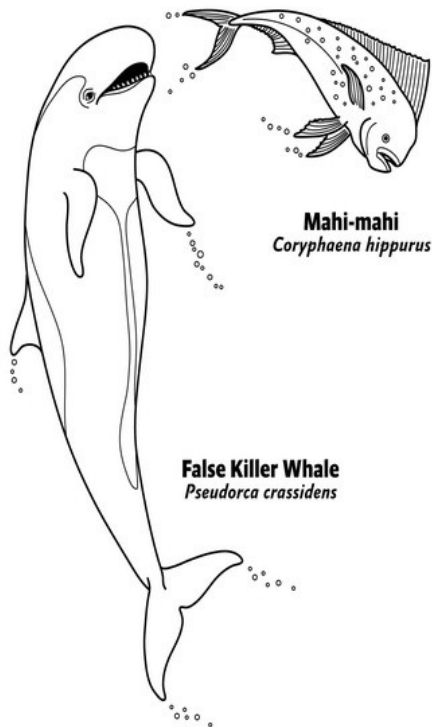

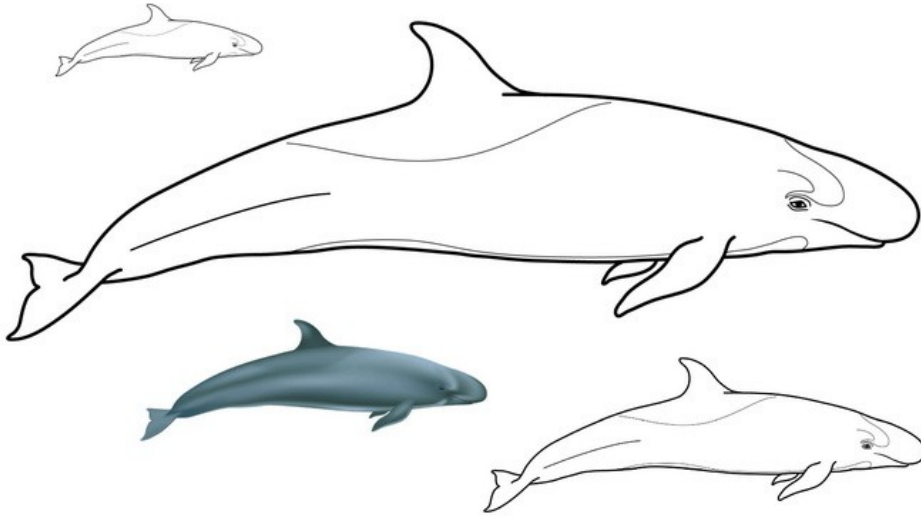

At the bottom you will find words that scientists often use when talking about false killer whales. Find these commonly used terms hidden in the puzzle. One of the words is circled for you as an example.

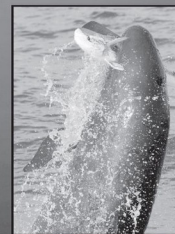
