**Privacy Act Statement
Collection and Use of Personal Information**

Section 205(c)(2)(A) of the Social Security Act, as amended, allows us to collect your information, which we will use to (1) identify the wage earner, (2) establish the period of earnings information requested, (3) verify the wage earner authorized SSA to release this information to the requesting party and (4) produce the Itemized Statement of Earnings (SSA-1826). Providing the information is voluntary, but not providing all or part of the information may prevent an accurate and timely decision on any claim filed. As law permits, we may use and share the information you submit, including with other Federal agencies, contractors, and others, as outlined in the routine uses within System of Records Notice 60-0059, available at www.ssa.gov/privacy. The information you submit may also be used in computer matching programs for Federal benefits eligibility or to recoup debts under these programs.
