

**JUSTIFICATION FOR NON-SUBSTANTIVE CHANGE TO APPROVED
INFORMATION COLLECTION**

This ICR seeks to make a non-substantive change to a currently approved generic data collection. OSHA is requesting to include modified data collection instruments in this ICR. Modifications are made to the:

- Safe + Sound Event Registration and the
- Safe + Sound Feedback Forms

These modifications are described in two separate uploaded documents titled:

And

- Mark Up_ S+S Week Event Registration Form Questions 2024_Generic_7-11-24.docx

which will allow OSHA to better understand how participants engage with the Campaign and their experiences related to participation. The proposed modifications are based on an analysis of responses over the past two years and advances in technology to assist participants in completing the forms. The final versions of the proposed new forms are uploaded over the previous forms under the IC so that the old versions will no longer show as valid to the public after this conclusion is issued. Also, these changes will not affect the burden hours and cost.
